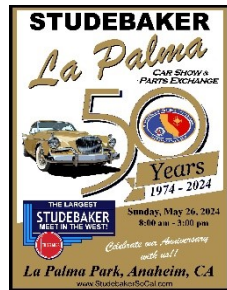




PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE MAY MADNESS

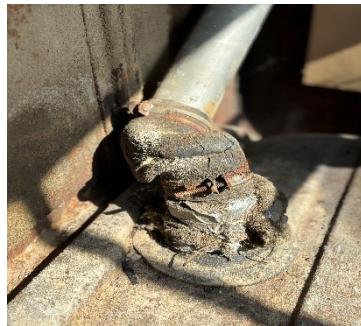
CAR PROJECTS

My journey to bring the fuel system to a safe drivable condition on my 1950 Studebaker 2R11 truck

RICKY LOGIER Part 1

1st I had to remove the bench seat inside truck cab for access to the gas filler pipe and fuel sending unit.

I disconnected 2 wires to the top of fuel sending unit. Disconnected 2 rusted clamps holding the rotted rubber hose from the filler pipe connecting gas tank pipe. Unscrewed the neck grommet on the floor holding the gas tank pipe in place.



To remove gas tank I placed 2 Jack stand under tank to hold in place, then remove drain plug and drain any fuel inside tank. There are 2 bolts at each end of the gas tank. 2 of the bolts were frozen had to use impact wrench to remove. Once tank is removed time to remove fuel sending unit. Next wash inside and outside of tank. I was surprised to see the tank had been painted military olive green originally. The outside of the tank was sanded and coated with rust reformer. The inside of the tank was sealed using POR15 fuel tank repair kit a 3 step process. To be continued Part 2.

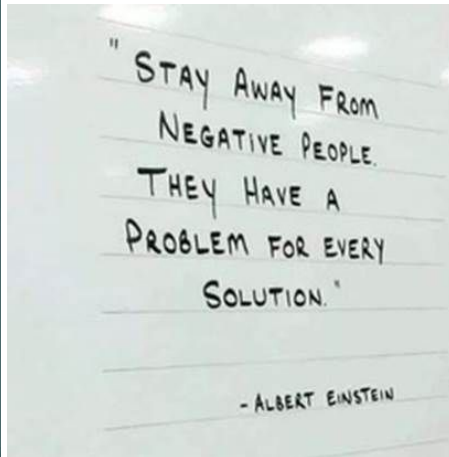
